Reading

- ❖ A progressive development of reading comprehension ensures students gain more from what they read.
- ❖ An emphasis on text complexity and sophistication in grade level texts promotes necessary rigor.

Writing

- ❖ Focuses on composing different types of writing:
 - Argumentative/Opinion pieces
 - Informative/Explanatory writings
 - Narrative texts
 - Research Projects
- ❖ Infuses use of technology in creation, refinement, and collaboration in writing.

Speaking and Listening

- ❖ Focuses on speaking and listening in a range of settings, both formal and informal in small group and whole class discussion.
- ❖ Emphasizes effective communication practices.
- ❖ Requires interpretation and analysis of message as presented through oral, visual or multimodal formats.

Language

- ❖ Includes conventions for writing and speaking.
- ❖ Requires vocabulary and correct grammar to be addressed in context of reading, writing, speaking, and listening.

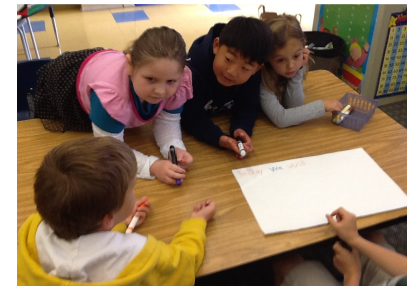

Mathematical Practice

- ❖ Make sense of problems and persevere in solving them.
- ❖ Reason abstractly and quantitatively
- ❖ Construct viable arguments and critique the reasoning of others
- ❖ Model with mathematics
- ❖ Use appropriate tools strategically
- ❖ Attend to precision
- ❖ Look for and make use of structure
- ❖ Look for an express regularity in repeated reasoning.

Mathematical Content

- ❖ K-5 Develop a strong concrete to conceptual foundation in number and operations, including fractions and decimals.
- ❖ 6-8 Develop a robust understanding of algebra, geometry, probability, and statistics.

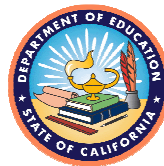
