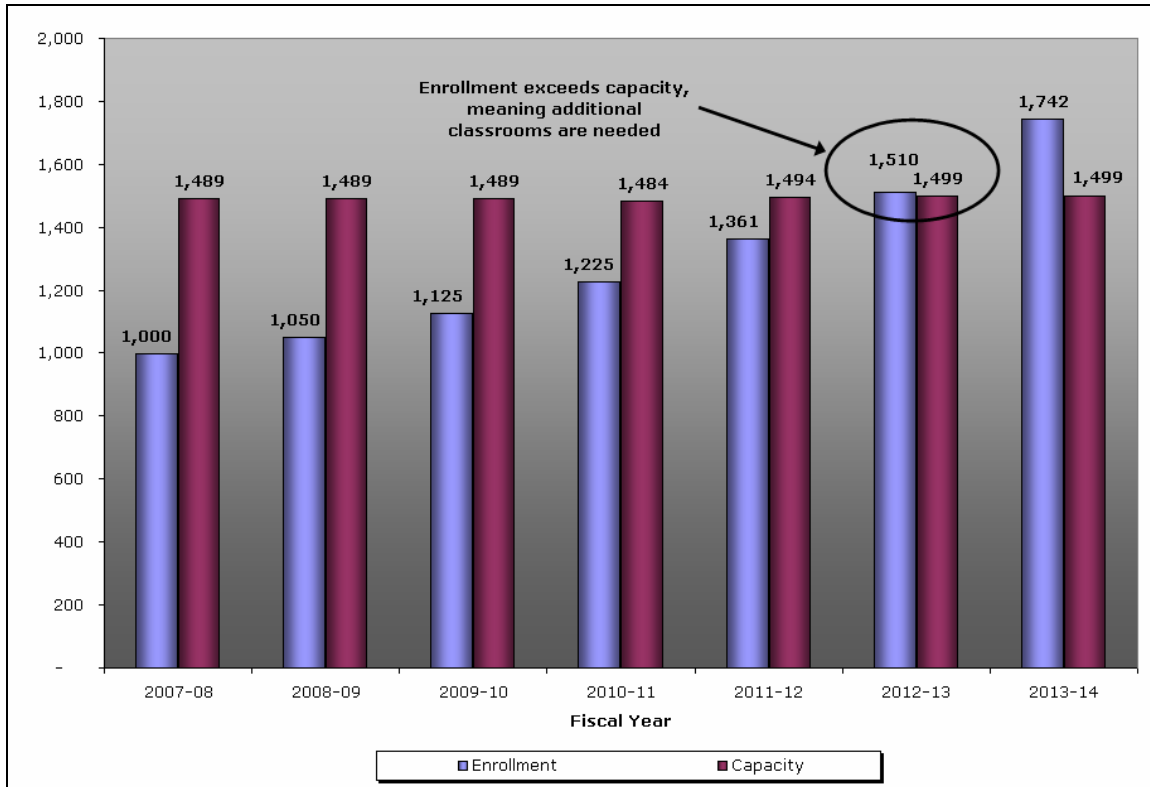


- The County of Yuba has now approved a plan to fund the levy improvements necessary to continue development in the Plumas Lake Specific Plan.
  - As a result, developers/home builders will be permitted to construct new housing units.
- Based on current development projections and the District's historical student generation rate of 0.516 students per home, District enrollment will exceed school site capacity by the 2012-13 school year.



- The Board has stated that the next school to be built in the district should be a middle school.
  - It is essential to provide a facility which will meet the programmatic needs of middle school students.
- It takes at least 4 years to design and construct a middle school facility, including the time needed for the necessary State approvals.
  - To prevent overcrowding at the District's existing schools, and to have a new middle school facility ready to occupy for the 2012-2013 school year, the District will need to begin the planning phase for a new middle school by the beginning of the 2008-09 school year.
  - The Design and approval process, as well as actual student enrollment trends, will be monitored so that construction can be phased when funding is available.
