



PARENT COMMUNICATION SURVEY

We would like to share some of the information the district gathered during the recent Parent Communication Survey, here are a few of the highlights:

- ????????169 people completed the survey out of a possible 699 families.
- ????????The 3 schools had similar participation rates
- ????????80.3% of parents responded that they agreed or strongly agreed that the school's communication was effective.
- ????????77.4% of parents responded that they agreed or strongly agreed that the district's communication was effective.
- ????????79% of people often or regularly look at the district/school website.
- ????????Currently the district communicated through fliers/newsletters (28.2%), Phone calls (22.8%), and emailed information (21.7%).
- ????????Parents would prefer communication with through email (32.5%), Fliers (19%), and phone calls (18.5%)
- ????????When the school or district want parent input parents would like to complete an on-line survey (51.9%), complete a paper survey (16.9%), or attend community forums (16.9%).

PTO MEETING



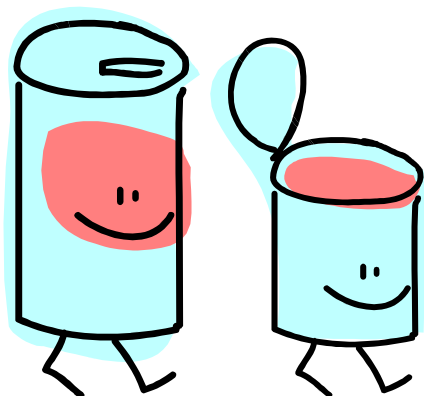
The next PTO meeting will be Tuesday, October 20th at 6:30pm in Room 13 in Building E.
