also called *reciprocal*.The multiplicative inverse of $\frac{3}{4}$ is $\frac{4}{3}$.

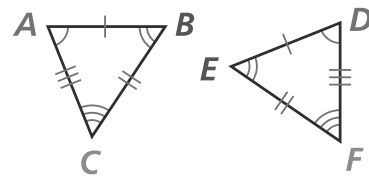
Chapter 4 (p. 192)

reciprocalOne of two numbers whose product is 1;
also called *multiplicative inverse*.The reciprocal of $\frac{2}{3}$ is $\frac{3}{2}$.

Chapter 5 (p. 258)

corresponding angles

Matching angles of two or more polygons.

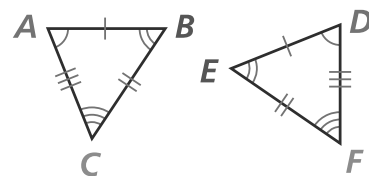


$\angle A$ and $\angle D$ are corresponding angles.

Chapter 5 (p. 258)

corresponding sides

Matching sides of two or more polygons.



\overline{AB} and \overline{DE} are corresponding sides.

Chapter 5 (p. 236)

rate

A ratio that compares two quantities measured in different units.

The speed limit is 55 miles per hour, or 55 mi/h.

ratio

A comparison of two numbers or quantities.
